<i>Julbernardia globiflora</i>	Muhimbe	Bark fibre-ropes, timber, beehives, canoes, corn bins & sacks, mortars	1850
<i>Millettia stuhlmanii</i>	Panga Panga	Timber, flooring blocks, medicine	1698
<i>Pterocarpus angolensis</i>	Kiaat - Rhodesian Teak - Mukwa Bloodhood	Timber (valuable), canoes, fuel, tanning leather. Works easily and is very resistant to fire and grow easily.	483
<i>Dalbergia melanoxylon</i>	Blackwood / Zebrawood	Timber (valuable) - Trinket boxes, chessmen, small ornaments, particularly for woodwind musical instruments and medicine. Local people also use it for arrow tips and wooden hammers.	0
<i>Azelia quanzensis</i>	Pod Mahogany	Timber (Valuable), fodder, butterflies, birds, dugouts, medicine. Seeds are much in demand for ornaments and charms and often strung into necklaces or made into trinkets, which are sold, as curios.	515
<i>Acacia nigrescens</i>	Knob-thorn	Timber - furniture, mine props, fencing posts and jukskeie, fodder (pods), butterflies, firewood, tanning.	0
